1. OECD call for revisions of Frascati Manual

In response to the OECD call for revisions of the Frascati Manual, and in tandem with the Norwegian Artistic Research Foundation and ELIA, SAR proposed "that artistic research becomes a field of its own on the 1-digit level in the Frascati classification".
